

Toronto Grace Health Centre Fact Sheet

- 119 bed facility located at Bloor and Church Street.
- Toronto Grace is owned and operated by The Salvation Army.
- Specializes in Palliative Care, Slow-Paced Rehabilitation, and Complex Continuing Care.
- Toronto Grace Foundation established in 2002 and raises money for the Health Centre through planned giving, an annual Golf Tournament, a gala and a Tree of Memories campaign.
- The Neuromuscular Support Program on the 3rd floor offers care and support to individuals who have experienced a stroke, brain hemorrhage or brain injury and to those with other neuromuscular conditions.
- The Complex Systems Support Program located on the 4th floor provides patient centred care designed to improve the quality of life for individuals who have chronic diseases and/or complex medical conditions by improving or restoring their functional abilities.
- The Transitional and Continuing Care Program on the 5th floor serves medically complex patients whose condition requires a hospital stay, regular onsite physician care and assessment as well as active care management from an interdisciplinary.
- Our 6th floor Palliative Care Unit integrates the physical, psychological and spiritual aspects of care, offering patients a support system that enables them to live as actively as possible until the end.
- The Community Palliative Care Program involves our physicians providing 24 –hour on-call holistic comfort and support to patients and their families. Physicians visit patients as home on a regular basis to check their medications, ensure proper pain management and provide overall care and comfort.
- Toronto Grace believes that Spiritual Care is intrinsic to well-being; our mission is to support patients and their families in a manner that respects the individual’s own spiritual journey, faith and cultural diversity.
- To date over 59% of the Grace’s Slow-Paced Rehabilitation patients have been able to return to the community.
